Slate 2000 on Modular Housing

Due to the slate 2000 true broken bond traditional slate finish we have been specified on many modular housing projects where traditional tiles and slates were impractical to use due to the very heavy weight of the products.

Britmet Tileform Slate 2000 was selected from all its competitors due to its genuine traditional slate appearance and specified on over 2000 houses across 17 sites across the country by a major housing developer.

Britmet Tileform then had to train the developers installing teams on how to fix the Britmet Tileform Slate 2000 system. This at first was not as easy as expected, due to the installers all used to fixing traditional concrete tiles. Lifting very heavy concrete tiles all day and laying them singly and using wet cement for holding down the ridges and verges was their traditional methods.

Britmet Tileform decided the best way to train was on site, where we had the slate 2000 and flashing pack in quantities to suit each house which was lifted in one load by the forklift onto the scaffolding. Each contain approx. 120 no slate 2000 and 35 no flashings, weighing less than 500 kg. The traditional tile equivalent was 3 pallets of concrete tiles and flashings weighing 2900kg. Each Slate 2000 has 5 slate repeats in its profile so is up to 5 times faster to fit compared to the traditional tile, The Britmet Slate 2000 accessories have a cover length of 1.15m compared to the traditional concrete ridges of 450mm, 3 times the size and 3 times faster to fix.

The developer's installers quickly gain confidence with the Britmet Slate 2000 installing methods and took one day for a team of 2 men to finish the first roof. The installers had no heavy concrete tiles to lift and wet cement to carry up steep ladders. The Britmet Slate 2000 dry fix installation system was a success from day one.

With superior performance to traditional materials, giving a strong and secure lightweight roofing system. Making it the perfect choice for a wide range of housing types from Non-traditional housing to flat to pitch roof conversions over existing blocks of maisonettes and flats, to replacement of existing traditional materials and all modular construction methods.
